




Rahul moved from India to Canada in 2022 as an international student. He found it tough being away from family and adjusting to a new culture, while working to improve his English. He was introduced to Foundry Abbotsford by a counsellor at his school.

He says, "When I first started coming to Foundry, I just wanted to try out some medications for what I was going through because I didn't have a family doctor coming here, which is really hard to find."

Rahul was immediately struck by the welcoming atmosphere at Foundry and had a positive introduction to socializing in a new culture. In fact, one year after becoming a client, Rahul decided to give back by volunteering at Foundry. He began as an outreach volunteer and later joined the Y-Fi committee, to provide input and feedback on Foundry programs.

"I like connecting with people who don't know about Foundry and helping them gain awareness," says Rahul.

BEV'S JOURNEY TO INDEPENDENCE

After living for 22 years in the United States, Bey returned to Canada after the death of her husband.

"Trying to get re-rooted was the most impossible task of my life. It took two years to prove I was a Canadian," said Bev. Without the proper documents to prove she was a Canadian citizen, Bev wasn't able to access Canadian Old Age Security, Guaranteed Income Supplement, or secure housing.

If that wasn't enough to deal with, Bev then took a fall and ended up in hospital. It was a blessing in disguise, since it led to a referral to Archway's Social Prescribing Program by the hospital social worker.

That's when things started to look up! Trina, the community connector at Archway, helped Bev get the documentation and support she needed, as well as find a living space that was suitable for her situation. Now, although she still has some challenges, Bev is feeling so much more optimistic about her life.

"I'm probably the youngest 73-year-old person you'll ever meet," Bev laughed. "I think young and want to stay active."

One of the ways Bev stays actively involved in her community is by attending Lunch with the **Bunch**, a weekly social gathering for seniors.

SARA AND WALIDA: THRIVING IN CANADA

Sara and Walida are two resilient young women, now aged 14 and 16, who grew up in Lebanon and moved to Canada eight years ago. Their new lives in Canada began with much uncertainty and many challenges.

Through the support of Archway's Immigrant Youth Services (IYS) program, they found a community that helped them navigate their new lives and develop essential skills.

IYS offers a variety of programs to help newcomer youth integrate into life in Canada, including after-school programs, one-on-one support, and culture club – a program run during lunch hour at seven middle and high schools in Abbotsford. It has provided a comfortable place for Sara and Walida to grow and prepare for jobs and university.

"Everyone is different, and everyone has left their home country and came here just like you. You don't have to be embarrassed about not speaking English very well because everyone is new," says Walida.

"There's no reason to be ashamed or afraid of being different," Sara adds.



TASTES OF HOME

Comforting and familiar food hampers for newcomers
