These two services are provided for seniors:

THE GOOD MORNING PROGRAM – Seniors are offered a quick call by a volunteer in the morning at a mutually agreeable time to chat and to check on their physical/mental well-being.

THE PEER SUPPORT PROGRAM – Seniors are matched with trained peer volunteers who offer one-on-one listening and emotional support, guidance, empathy and information to in-need peers living alone. Visits are once per week for one hour.

SENIORS ABUSE AND INFORMATION LINE & VICTIM SERVICES

The Seniors Abuse and Information Line (SAIL) is a confidential information line for older adults and those who care about them to speak to a professional intake worker about abuse, mistreatment and any issues that impact the health and well-being of older adults in BC. Language interpretation is available.

Identifying caller's issues and immediate, short-term, or potential long-term needs.

Completing intake to internal programs for callers to access SFBC services.

Providing general information and referrals to community and/or government services.

Providing follow-up calls to callers who are at risk.

Providing information about abuse and neglect, escalation, and risk.

Facilitating reporting of abuse, neglect, and self-neglect.

Calling Instructions:

callers will have to press "1" to be connected to a professional intake worker.

callers have an option to press "2" to leave a voicemail message for us to call back, without entering the queue.

calls will be returned from a private number, unless callers specify it is safe for us to do so.

When leaving a message, please state whether it is safe to leave a message. ***We will not leave a message unless specified to do so.***

If you discover a crime or dangerous situation is occurring to an older adult, ***call the police or 911 immediately.*** If you are not sure if an older person is being abused or neglected and you want to talk to a health professional, you can call **8-1-1** 24 hours a day for information and advice.

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DESCRIPTION OF LEVELS OF CARE FOR SENIORS' CARE FACILITIES



We recognize that different entities and care facilities refer to their services using varied language or differing terms. This is our attempt to synthesize the information into standard categories.



CONSIDERATE OF SENIORS

Care that is considerate of seniors recognizes that seniors may find themselves in varying situations at this stage of life. As each person is unique in their resources, experiences, and needs, so too must living arrangements and support be varied and unique. The following two types of living circumstances aim to address this reality and provide solutions that consider these seniors.



Independent Living

Means being **as self-sufficient as possible**. It means taking risks and being allowed to succeed and fail on your own terms. Independent Living means being able to exercise the greatest degree of choice about where you live, with whom you live, how you live, where you work, and how you use your time.



Integrated Living

Recognizes those seniors living in a lower income demographic who want to live **as self-sufficiently as possible** yet may benefit from some form of support. Supports can include things such as financial assistance, subsidized housing, meals, basic physical or relational needs, and even simply a supportive community environment. Integrated living meets you where you are at; it means being able to exercise choice about where you live, with whom you live, how you live, where you work, how you use your time and when or how you may need support.

DESCRIPTION OF LEVELS OF CARE FOR SENIORS' CARE FACILITIES



COMMUNITY LIVING CARE

Facilities provide accommodation, meals and care and supervision based on the person's needs. There are a wide variety of settings where community care is provided such as small home-like facilities for persons with physical or developmental disabilities, to large-scale facilities primarily for more frail elderly seniors, including those that are private pay, are licensed under the Community Care and Assisted Living Act or are licensed or designated under the Hospital Act, and have regular health and safety inspections. All types of licensed Complex Care facilities must follow the Residential Care Regulation and Standards of Practice.



Assisted Living

Provides housing, hospitality services and personal care services for adults who **can live independently but who may need minor help with daily care**. Assisted living facilities range in size from as few as 25 residents to 120 or more. Occupants live in apartment units furnished with their own furniture and belongings. They maintain a great deal of independence and privacy, while being supported with services according to the "level of care" they have requested. In addition to a basic monthly cost, most assisted living facilities provide the following services: Assistance with bathing, dressing, grooming, ambulating/transferring - Meals/snacks - Housekeeping and Laundry.



Long-Term Care / Complex Care (previously RESIDENTIAL CARE)

Fraser Health **provides long term care for adults who can no longer live safely or independently at home** due to their need for 24-hour nursing supervision in a secure environment, and their unpredictable or complex care needs which can no longer be managed in their home setting. Staff members administer medications and assist residents with daily activities such as eating, bathing and dressing. Care provided in these facilities have the goal to preserve an individual's comfort, dignity and quality of life as their needs change, and to offer ongoing support for family and friends. **Clients must meet Home and Community Care requirements and criteria for admission**. A health care needs assessment will be completed to confirm eligibility. Referral by case manager at a Home and Community Care office is required.

END OF LIFE CARE

Facilities for end-of-life care support seniors in the final stages of life who have a life-limiting or terminal illness. Comfort, dignity, quality of life, pain management, and continuous support are typical of these facilities, though the services can be provided in a home or hospital as well.

Palliative Care

Fraser Health provides ***care for individuals living with life-limiting illness.*** The services aim to preserve an individual's comfort, dignity, and quality of life as their needs change, and to offer on-going support for family and friends. Palliative services provided in the home, hospital (i.e. palliative complex care unit), in a long-term facility and/or at hospice. These services include the following: care co-ordination and consultation, pain and symptom management, community nursing services, community rehabilitation services, home support, respite for the caregiver and hospice care. Palliative care is comfort care with or without curative intent. Your Health care provider may suggest this service to you.



Hospice Care

Fraser Health provides a home-like setting for people in the last weeks or months of life when care cannot be managed at home. The services are provided 24 hours, daily, by a team of health care professionals who maximize comfort for a person who is terminally ill by reducing pain and addressing physical, psychological, social and spiritual needs. Hospice is comfort care without curative intent; the patient no longer has curative options or has chosen not to pursue treatment because the side effects outweigh the benefits. Referral required. Initial intake assessments through Fraser Health palliative care and home health services.

FACILITIES FOR SENIORS



When an individual requires additional support due to declining strength, they can either choose to stay at home and obtain the necessary assistance or relocate to a facility that provides the extra support. These are several things to keep in mind when the decision is made to move to a facility:

- The care may be private or subsidized, this means it is fully paid by the individual or is partially subsidized.
- There are various levels of care provided – depending on the facility.
- There is a process to be admitted to the best suited and preferred facility. The process will depend on whether the care is paid privately or subsidized.
- The process may take considerable time.
- There is often a waiting list to be admitted into a person's preferred facility.
- It is wise to be informed about the various facilities and also begin the necessary steps before a person needs to move from a home into a facility or to another level of care.
- If an individual is on a waiting list for a facility and receives a phone call to advise them that a space has opened up, the placement may be deferred and one may remain on the waiting list until such a time as they are ready to take that step.

The process of moving is coordinated in partnership with the ACCESS program of the Fraser Health Authority. The Fraser Health Authority also provides the operational funding.

Trillium Communities

Bevan Village is a three-storey long term care home accommodating long term care and independent/assisted living units over three floors. Owned and operated by Trillium Care Services Ltd. They aim to create a safe, caring environment for residents where quality care is achieved through partnerships with residents, families, staff, stakeholders and other community supports. The facility includes a fall prevention program, strength training, balance and endurance training are offered to high risk residents.



Abbotsford Hospice Society

Holmberg House is a beautiful new two-storey building owned and operated by the Abbotsford Hospice Society. The care team here can provide a hospice plus model of care. What that means is that people who need certain treatments like some intravenous medications, can now receive them in a hospice setting. It supports patients so that they are living their final days in comfort and not being transferred to hospital for periods of time to receive these types of procedures. Fraser Health is very pleased to partner with AHS in providing palliative care in the new 10-bed hospice located adjacent to the Abbotsford Regional Hospital and Cancer Centre Campus of Care. Each room includes an ensuite and piped in oxygen and suction at bedside.

Holmberg House was designed to feel like a home. The 2nd floor includes 10 private patient suites, a family kitchen & lounge, children's toys and games, a quiet/meditation room, and a sanctuary. There is also a beautiful garden and children's playground on our campus. Each one of our patient rooms feature a television, small fridge, radio/CD player, a desk and a wardrobe. Most rooms also feature a hide-a-bed where visiting family members can stay overnight if they wish. A sleeping cot can also be provided.


PREPARING TO CROSS THE FINISH LINE

Self-management refers to actions a person can do to live well with one or more chronic conditions. Train to become a certified UVic Self-Management BC Program Leader with our Fraser East Leader Team. Help adults, their caregivers and your community by co-facilitating our FREE health self-management workshops held with our venue partners in Abbotsford, Langley and Chilliwack. Ideal candidates will be familiar with the challenges of self-managing chronic conditions and/or pain. We also offer FREE 1-day Chronic Pain and Diabetes leader cross-trainings as well as ongoing professional development opportunities. As valued members of our Fraser East team, new leaders will receive an abundance of mentorship, encouragement and support from our highly experienced leaders and their Regional Coordinator.


