



How to Apply for Language Instruction for Newcomers to Canada (LINC) Classes

- Bring your completed application and copy of PR card (or Confirmation of Permanent Residence) to the Archway Community Services building located at **31943 S. Fraser Way Unit #102** near the ICBC driver's center.
- Give your completed application and copy of PR card to the staff at 31943 S. Fraser Way Unit #102 or email the completed application and copy of your PR Card to linc@archway.ca.

What happens next?

We will email or call you to schedule an appointment for an **English Assessment**. You will receive an appointment in about **2 weeks**. **YOU MUST ATTEND** this appointment in order to come to English Class.

At the appointment we will assess your listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills. This will determine what level you will be placed in. This assessment is for our classes only and is **NOT VALID for proof of Language for Canadian Citizenship**.

At the end of your appointment you will receive your level. You will be able to decide if you would like to go to morning or evening classes and which location you would prefer. If there is room in the class you have chosen, then you can start right away. If the class is full, you will be placed on the **waitlist**.

Waitlist

Sometimes you can get into class quickly and sometimes will have to wait. It is a good idea to **call the English office at (604) 859-7681 ext. 216** if you have been waiting for a month or longer. We will know you are still interested and can update you on how long you may have to wait.

If you have been waiting for a long time, you may want to consider starting at another location until there is room in your preferred class.
